These blocks are so versatile!

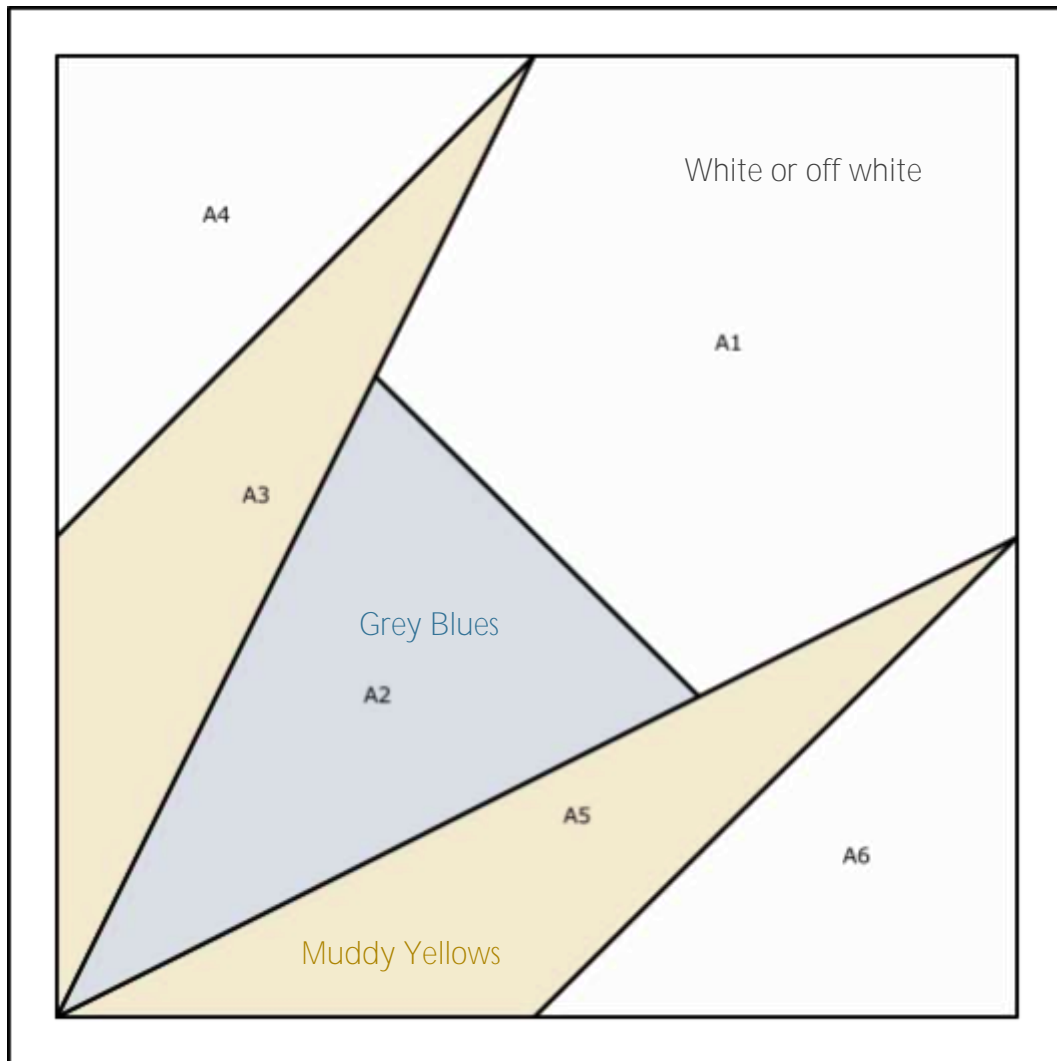

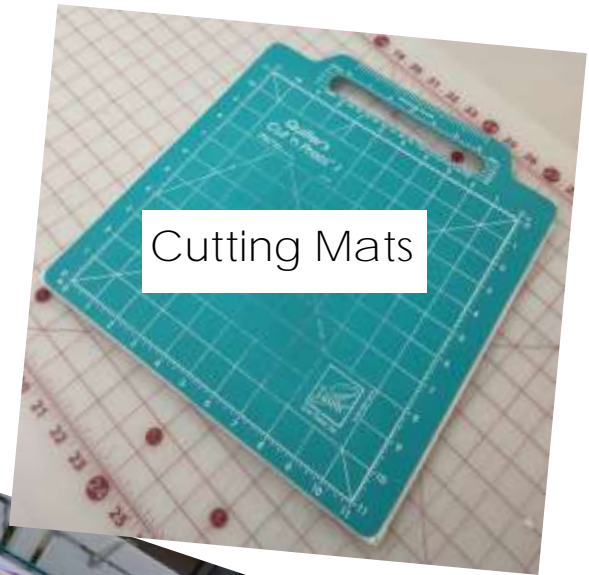
What are your must-have notions?

I am not a believer in needing every gadget known to sewists but there are certain things I just can't imagine living without! Some are the basics like cutting mats, rotary cutters, scissors. Others are things I don't use often but when I do they are invaluable like my solids color card! High quality FMQing thread is a must have too because I quilt all my own projects.

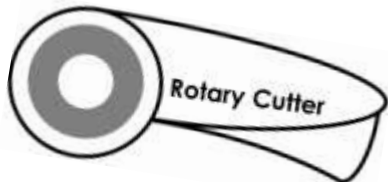

# Quarterly Tips and Tricks

## **Running out of background fabric?**



*In this quilt I ran out of the lovely ivory floral background fabric that I used for the center block, so I used my solids color card to color match the background from the floral fabric and the outer borders were pieced with an ivory solid as the background fabric! It blended in really well & allowed me to finish the quilt the way I had wanted to & had been envisioning it in my head.*



## **Before you cast aside imperfect blocks due to misaligned points...**

*Consider using them in pillow covers and adding buttons over the misaligned points to embellish the pillow cover!*

# Design Analysis Tutorial

Fantastic quilt designs don't always have to be made up of difficult design elements or have a multitude of elements. Quilts are often amazing in their simplicity. The factor that makes them eye catching is often simply the use of repetition & reflection of the basic quilt design elements .





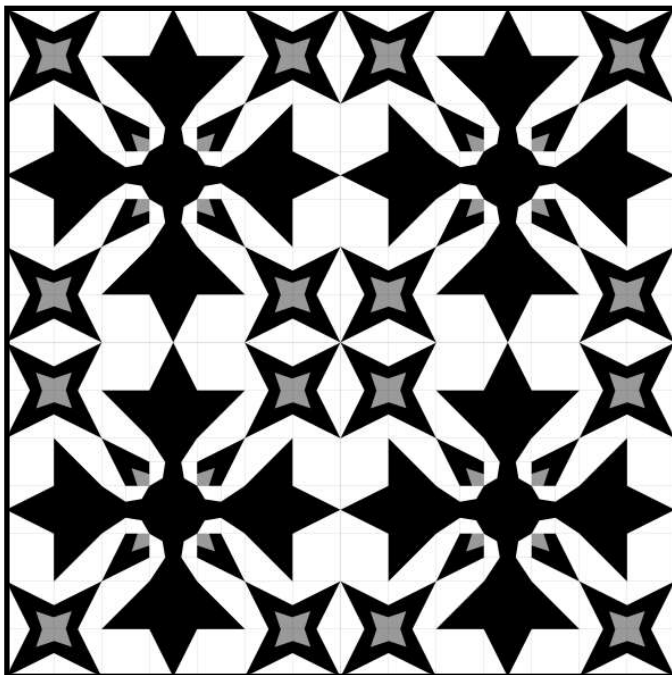
## Quilt Example

4 relatively easy to construct FPP quilt block designs:

- HST
- Triangle in a square (geese)
- Quadrants of a basic large quadrant star
- 1 custom designed FPP block for this design



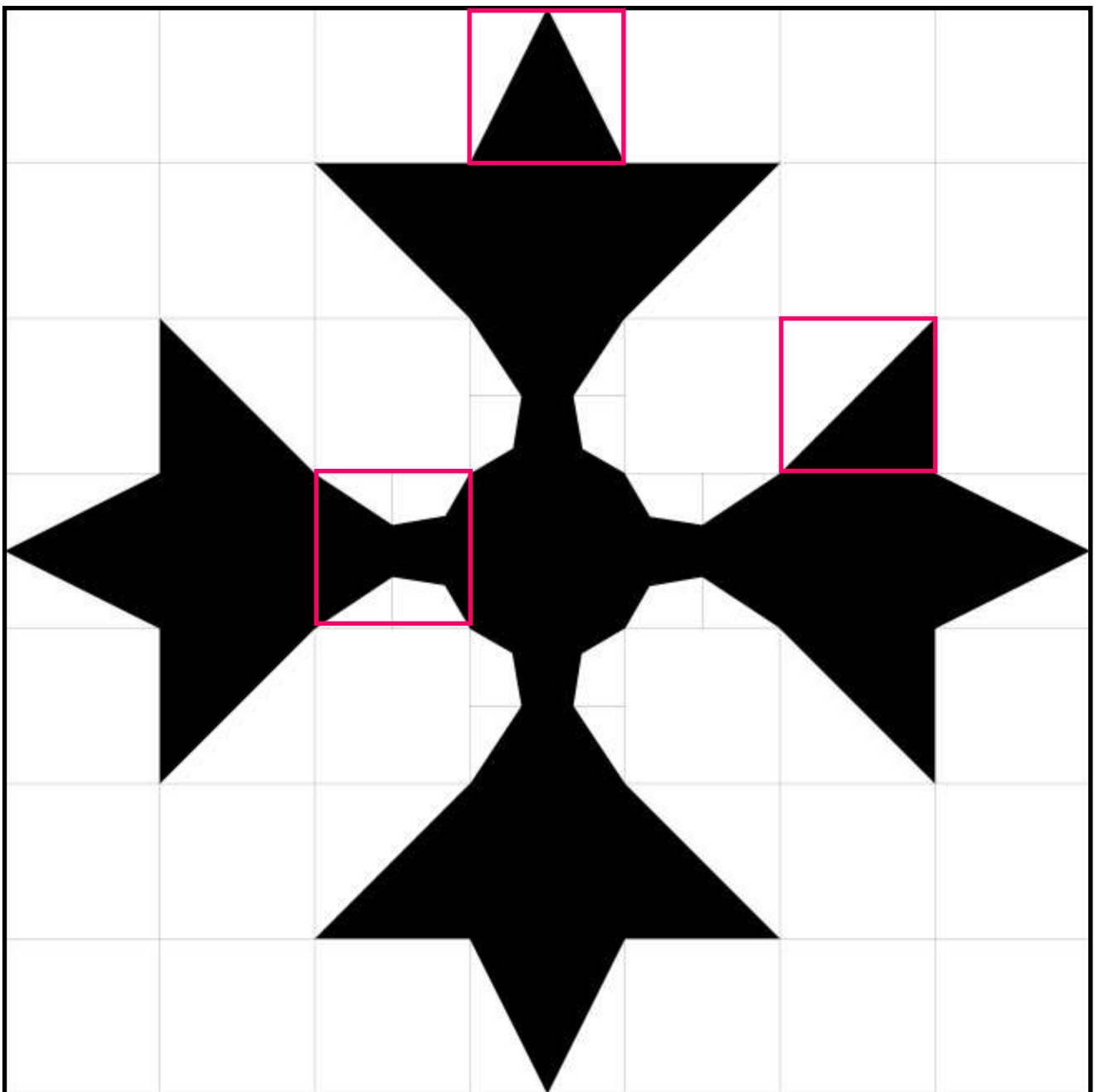
These 2 fantastic designs use only these 4 elements!



## The basic block:

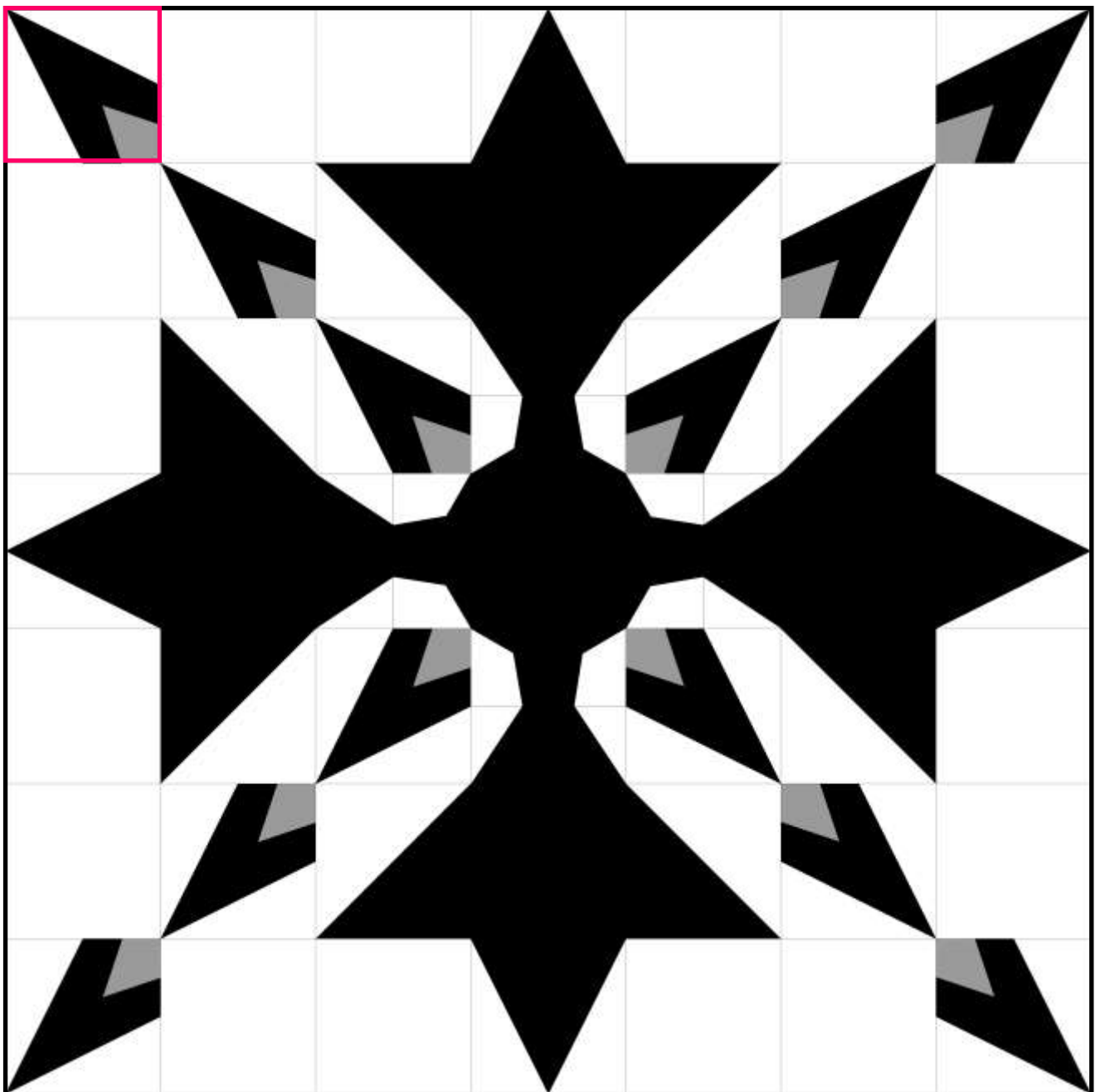
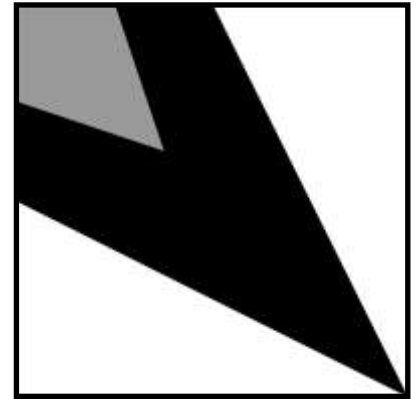
This basic design uses only 3 of the 4 elements the 3 blocks are shown highlighted by the pink squares.

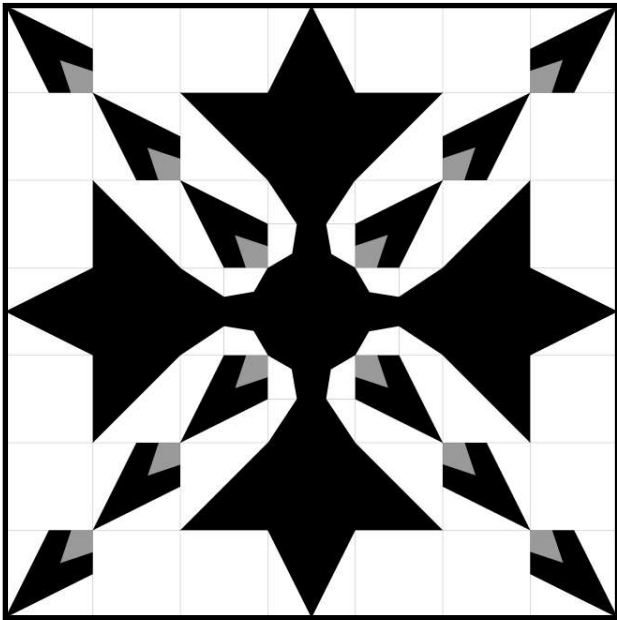
All remaining squares are either white background fabric or black feature fabric squares.



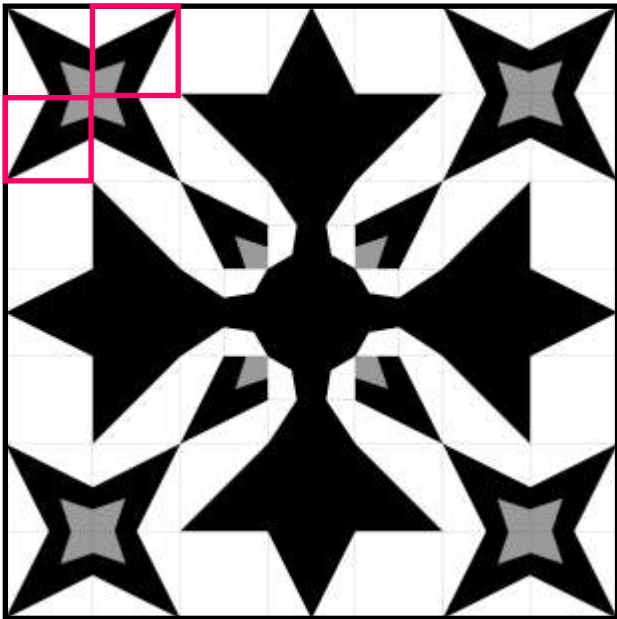
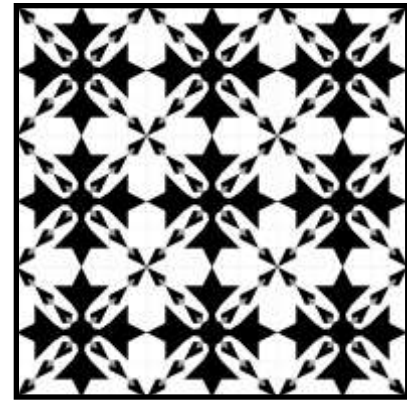
Adding to the basic block:

In this next step the large quadrant star quadrant has been used to add diagonal directionality to the basic block.

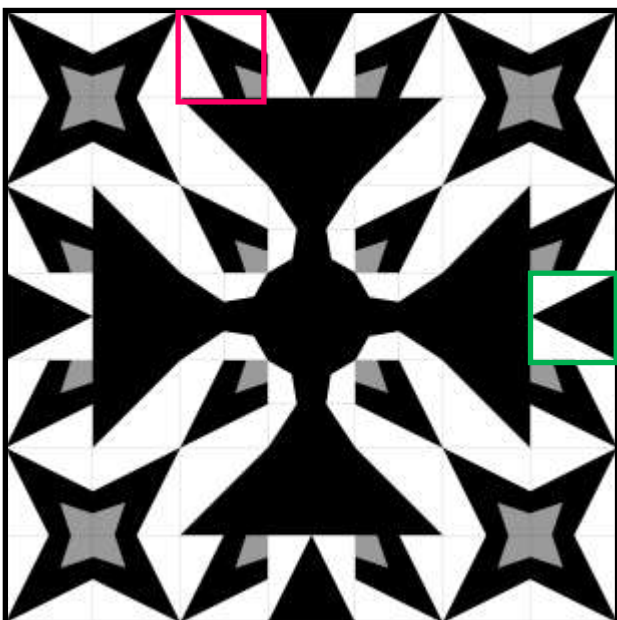
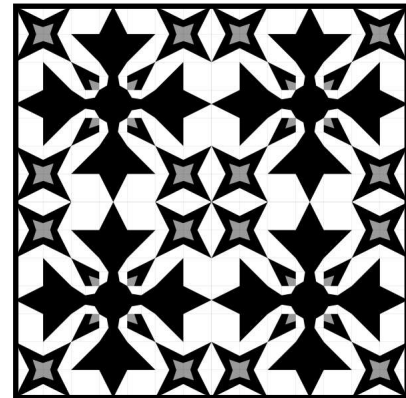




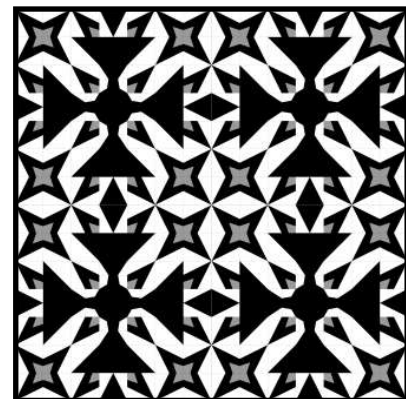
Example 1; features the basic LQS in diagonal directionality as shown on the previous page

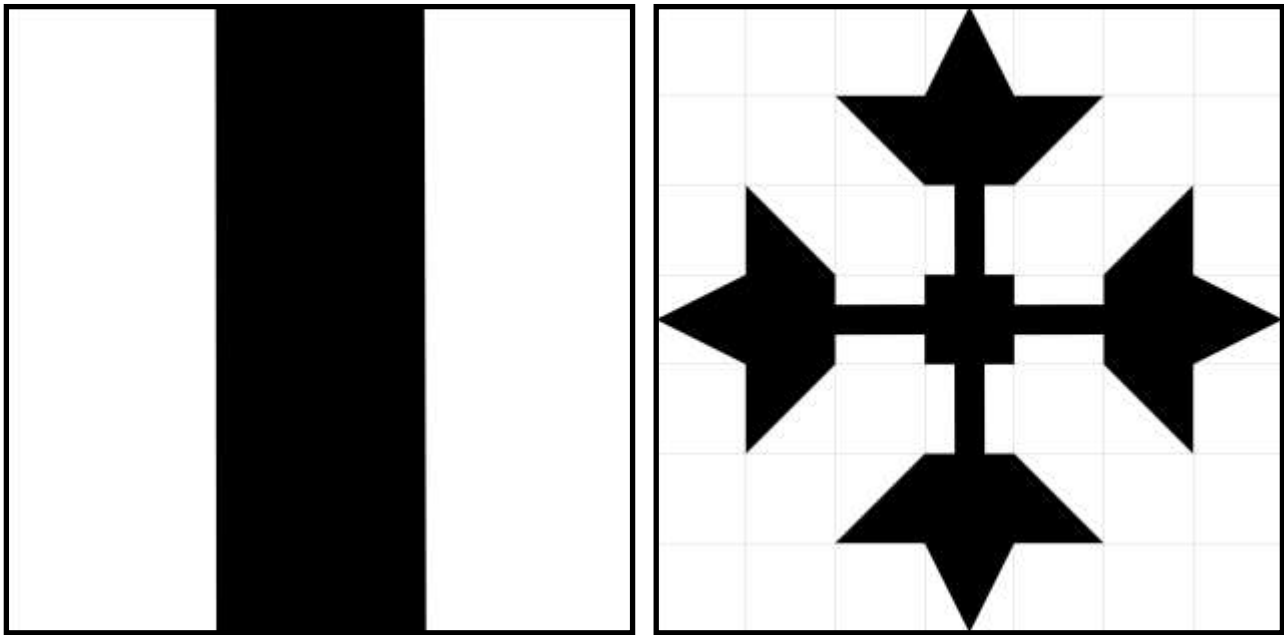


Example 2; features **two extra LQS elements** added to negative space in each corner of the block and adjacent to the corner LQS element. All the LQS elements are then rotated to achieve this striking variation with full large quadrant stars in each corner!

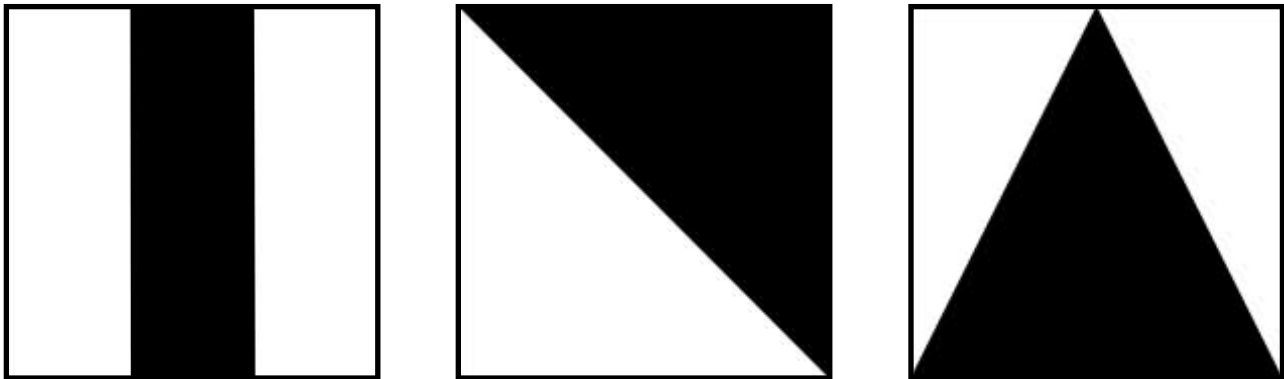


Example 3; **all remaining negative space white blocks are replaced by more LQS quadrants** & **the triangle in a square/geese element is then rotated.**





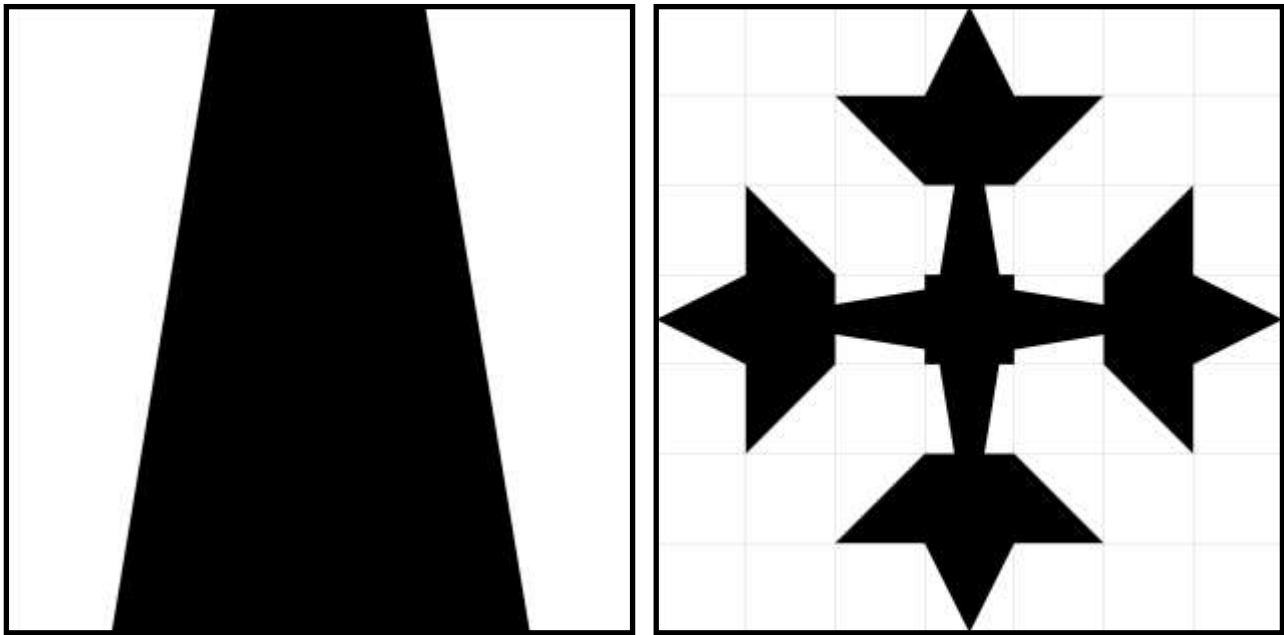
## Basic Block Simplification



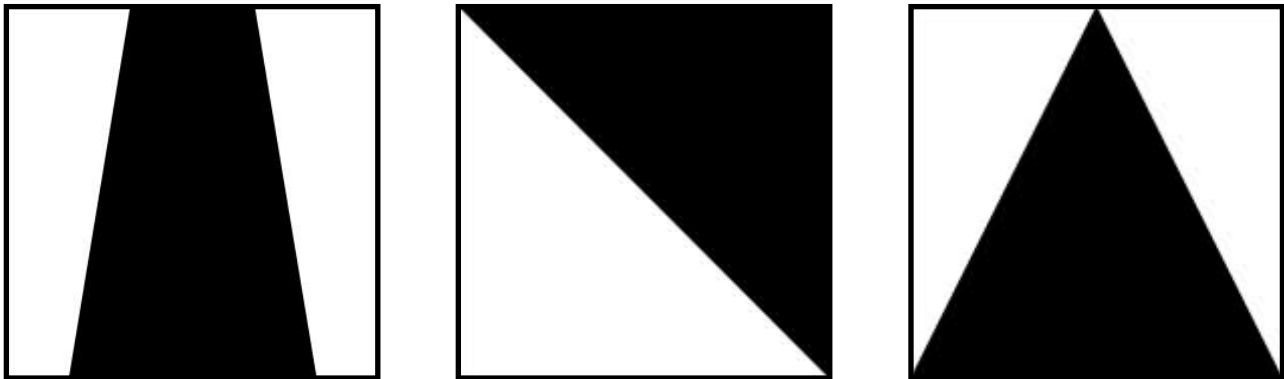
To further simplify the basic block even more a basic rail fence block can be used instead of the block I custom designed for the original layout!

This example uses white background fabric squares and

- 4 rail fence
- 8 HSTs
- 4 triangle in a square
- 5 black squares



## Basic Block Simplification



Another alternative simplification of the basic block uses a trapezoid rail fence block instead of the block I custom designed for the original basic block layout!

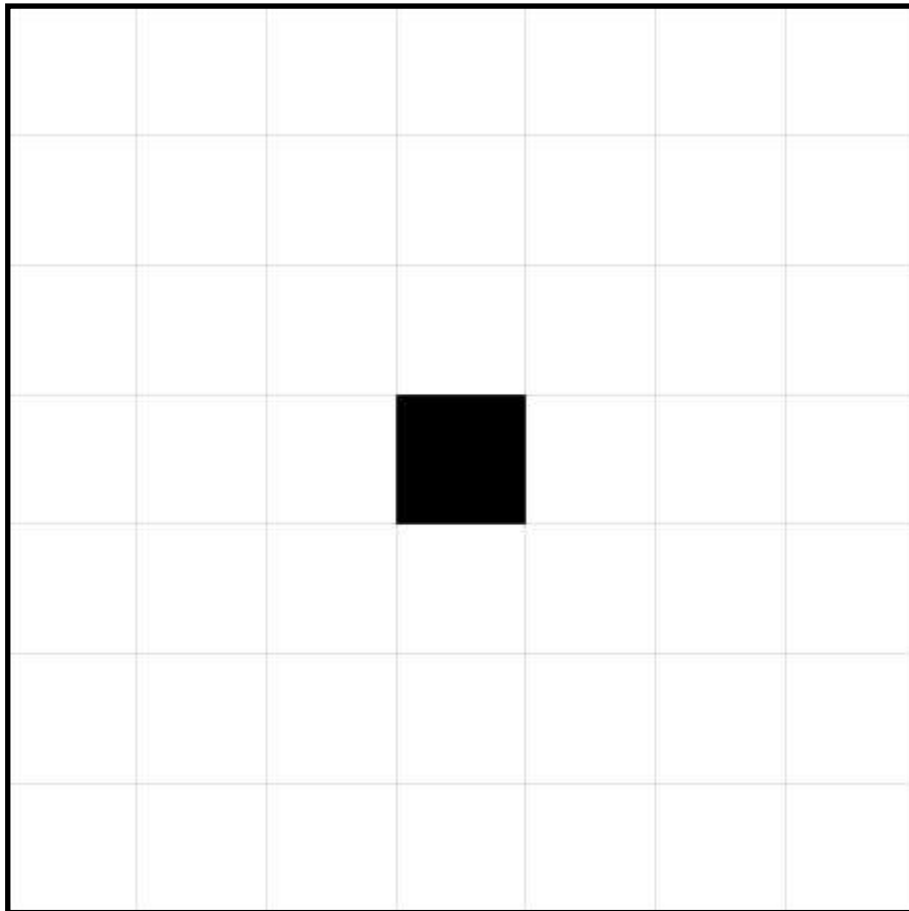
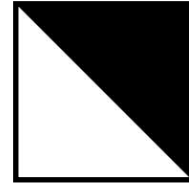
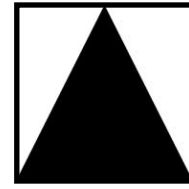

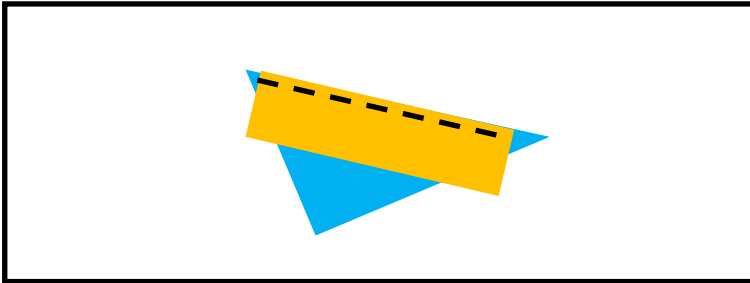
# Improv Foundation Piecing Scrap Strips



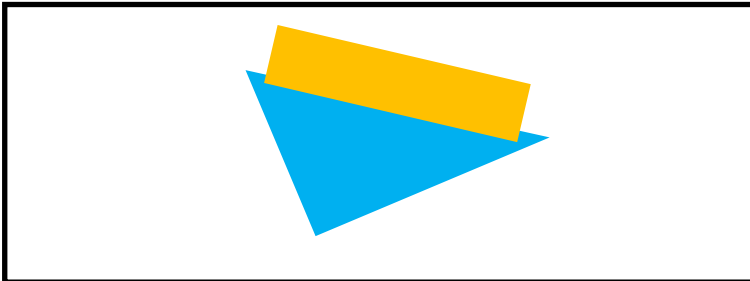
Cut letter paper in half to create paper strips.



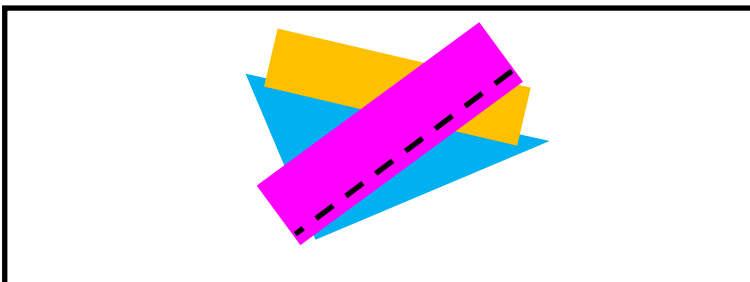
Place a piece of scrap fabric in the center at an angle.



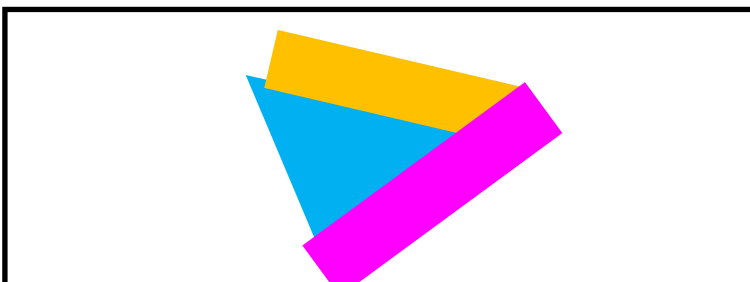
Place another piece of scrappy fabric on top aligned with one edge of the original fabric piece and sew a 1/4" seam as shown.



Press open.

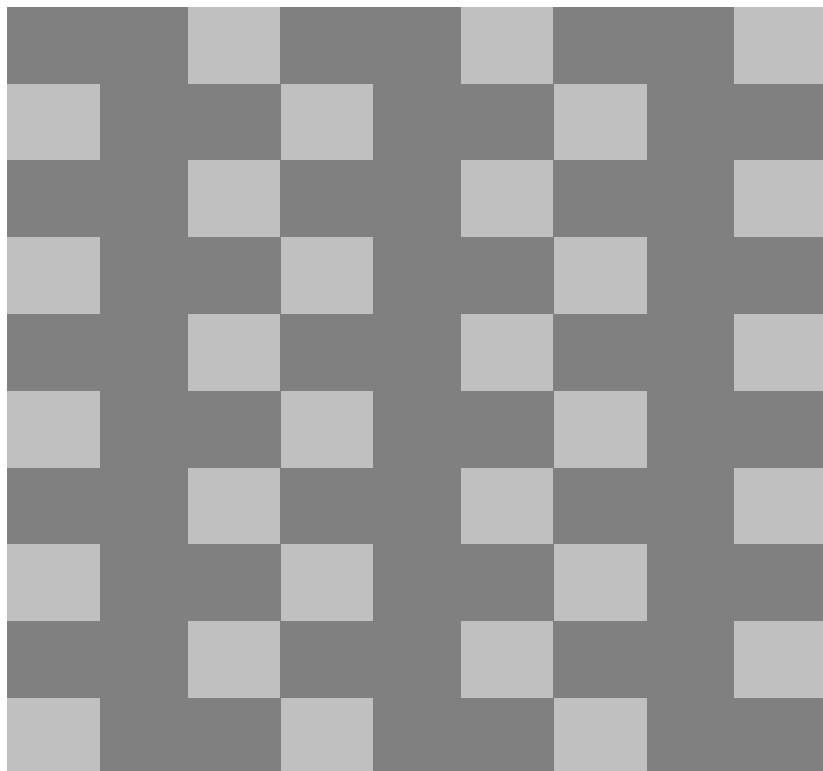


Place another scrap along one edge of the prior pieces. Stitch 1/4 seam to attach.



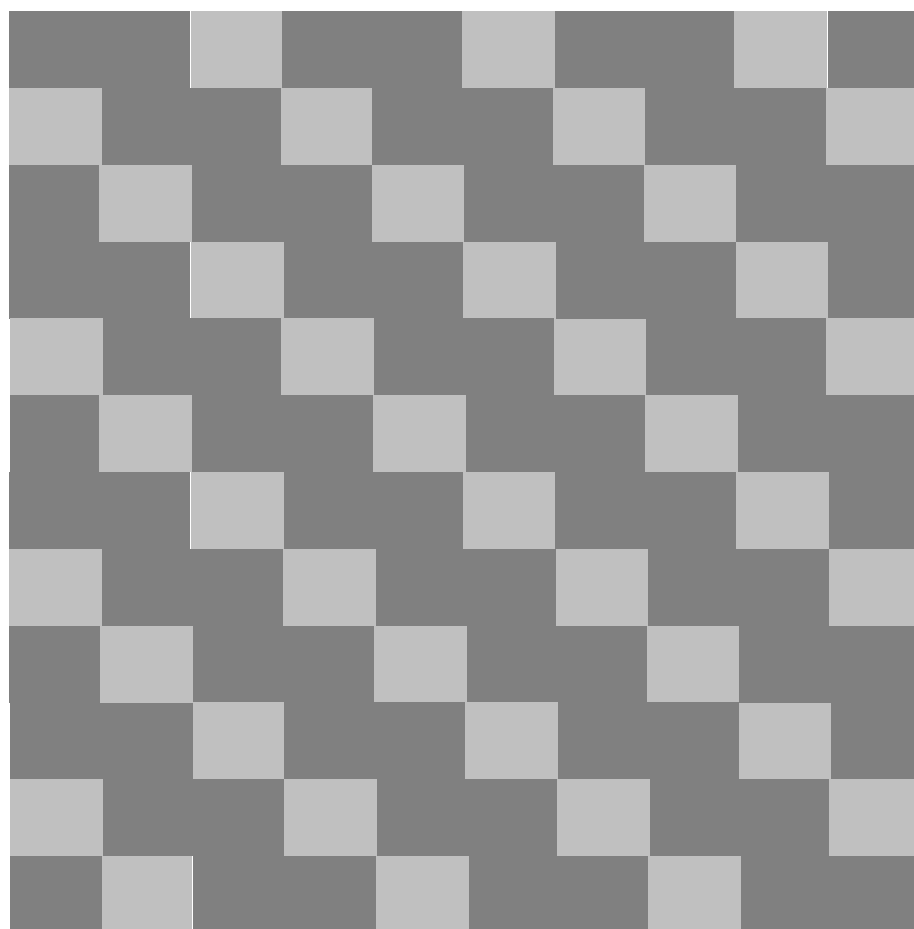
Press open & continue the improv foundation piecing process until entire piece of paper is covered, trim edges to complete the block.

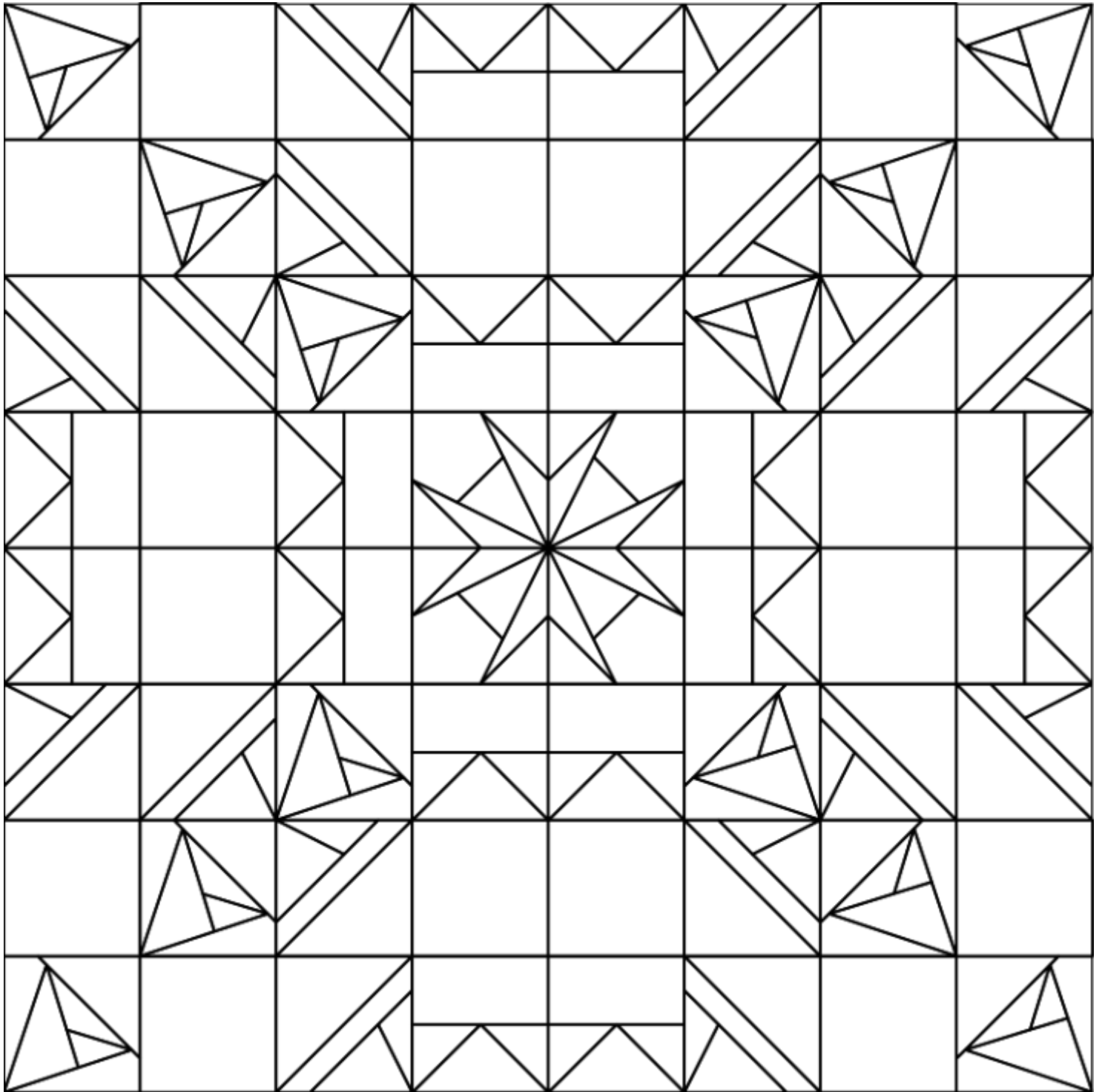
The best thing about this years design is that there are 4 layout options! (see page 7 for all 4 variations). The different layouts are achieved by altering the directionality of the April and October blocks!

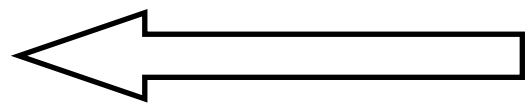
