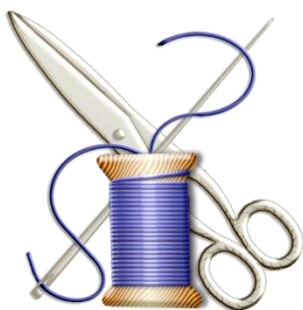


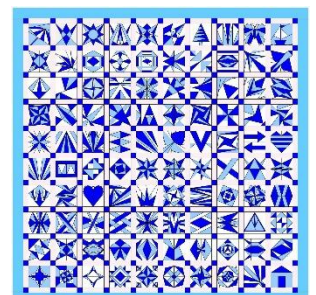

**Being a member of the #quiltpolice or an individual #quiltsnob does nothing for the quilting community and quilter development, it only makes you feel superior in the moment to the detriment of others. This craft is not yours to own only to participate in!**

Call out these types of people whenever you see this behavior to ensure a positive quilty community.  
*Traits of a quilt snob - Inconsiderate, superficial, indulgent, insecure, insincere, insulting, irrational, narcissistic, obnoxious, pretentious, bombastic and narrowminded*

"I'LL... "WHAT MAKES HER THINK SHE CAN!!" "ONLY HAND BINDING IS PROPER" "I CAN'T BELIEVE SHE DID ... TH... BETTER WAY" "SHE SHOULD USE A...
