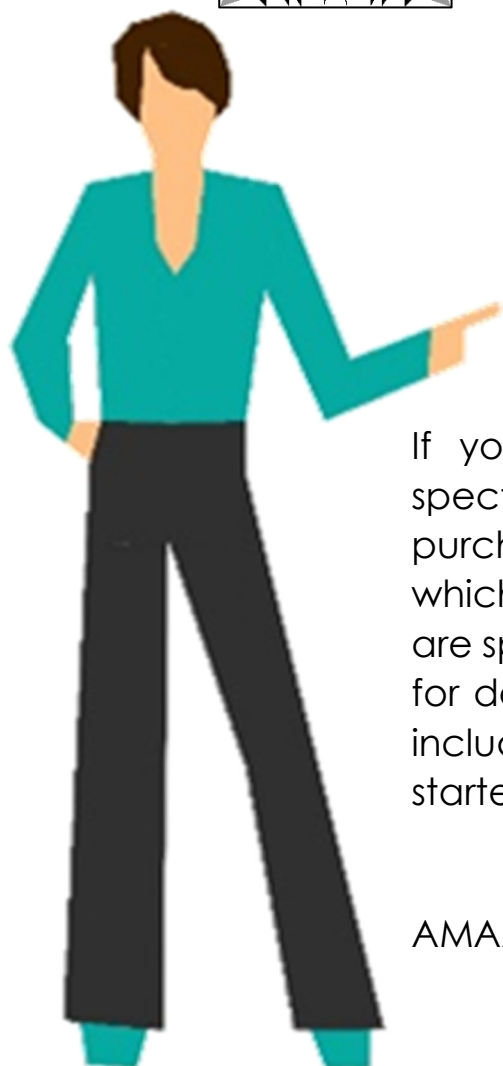
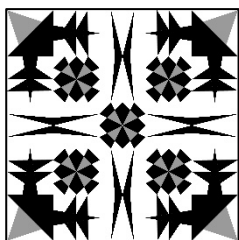
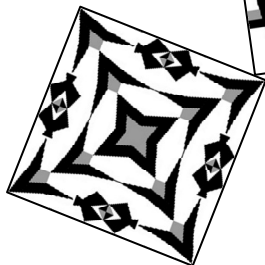
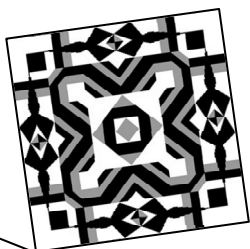
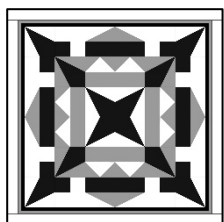


Blocks used:

Border two: 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14, blank squares of background fabric A

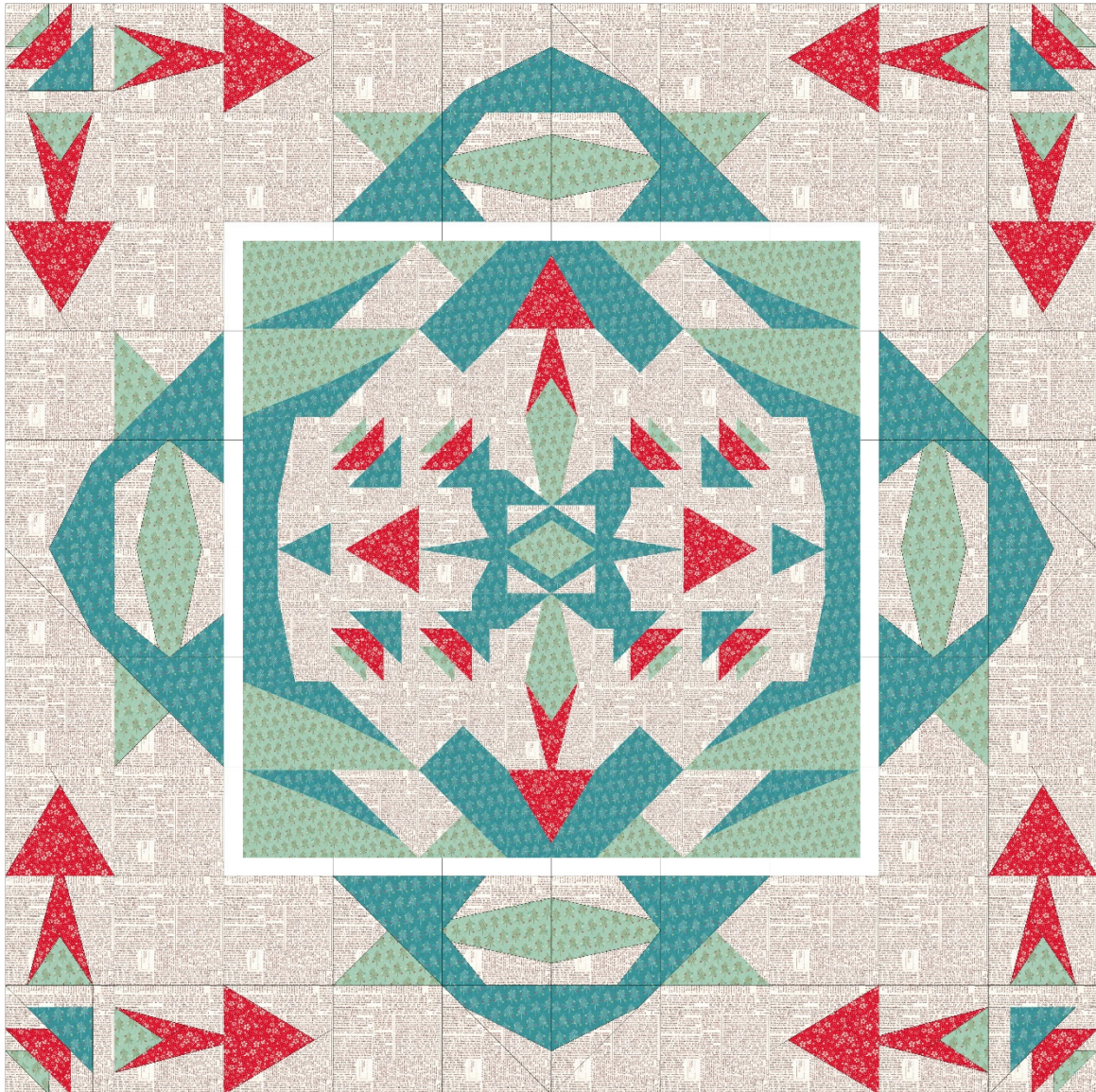
