



Scrap Sorting Tips

The first step when creating a scrap quilt is always to sort your scraps well!

1. Sort your scraps by color; **red**, **orange**, **yellow**, **green**, **blue**, **purple**, **pink**, **grey**, **black**, **brown** and white.



2. Now sort each color again into shades and tones; light, medium, dark, etc.

BLUE example scrap sorting shades and tones:

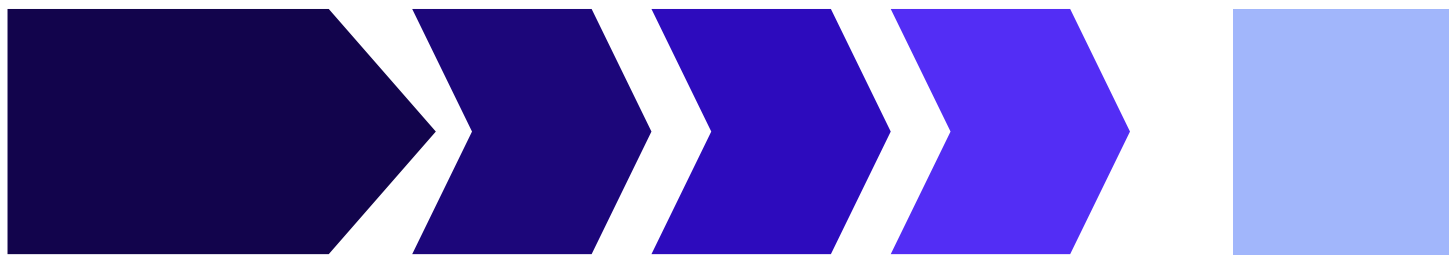
Purpley Blues

3. During this third phase sift out any scraps that might be off-color (not a true blue) for example a scrap might be described as purpley blue rather than a true blue.
