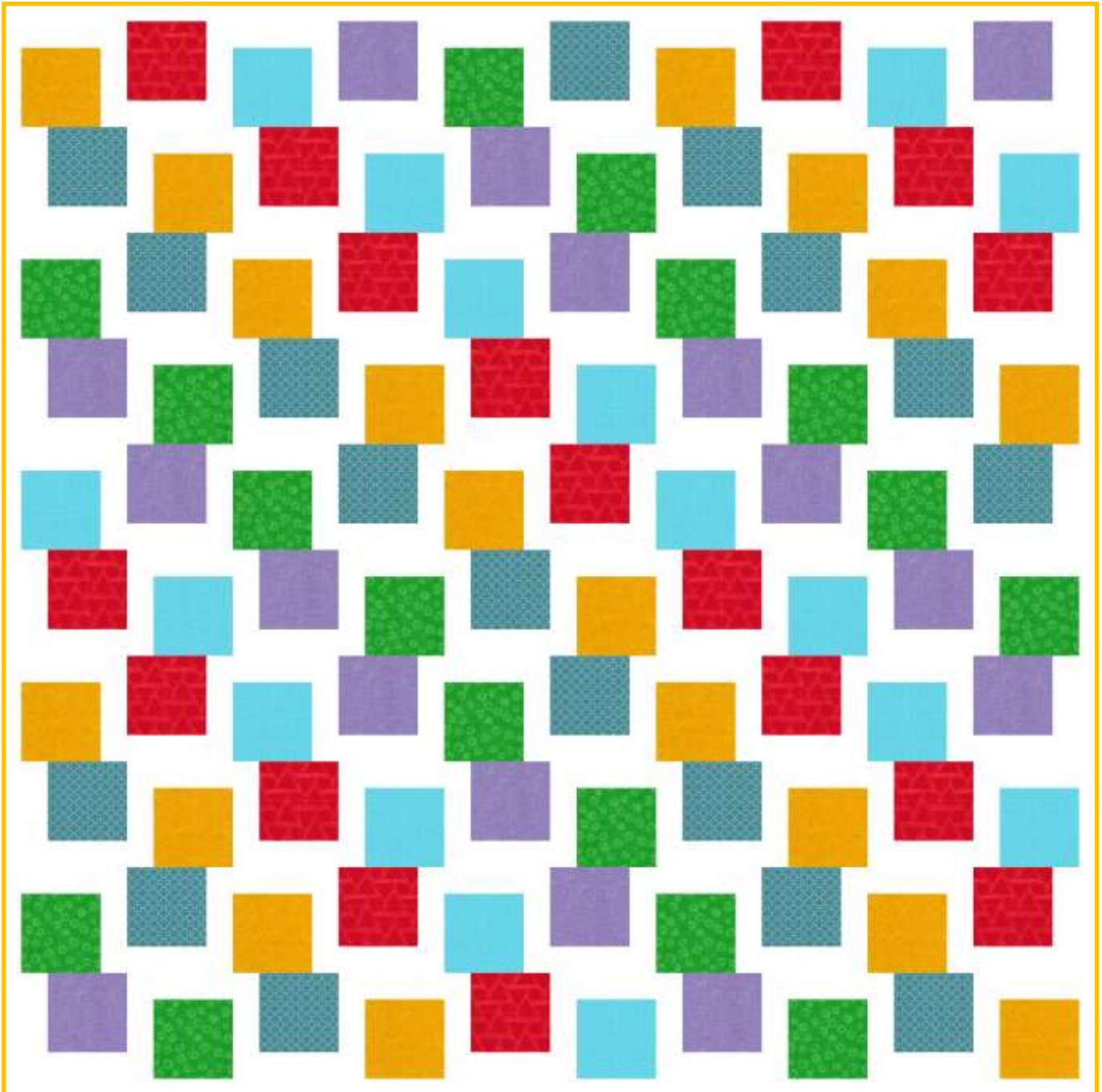


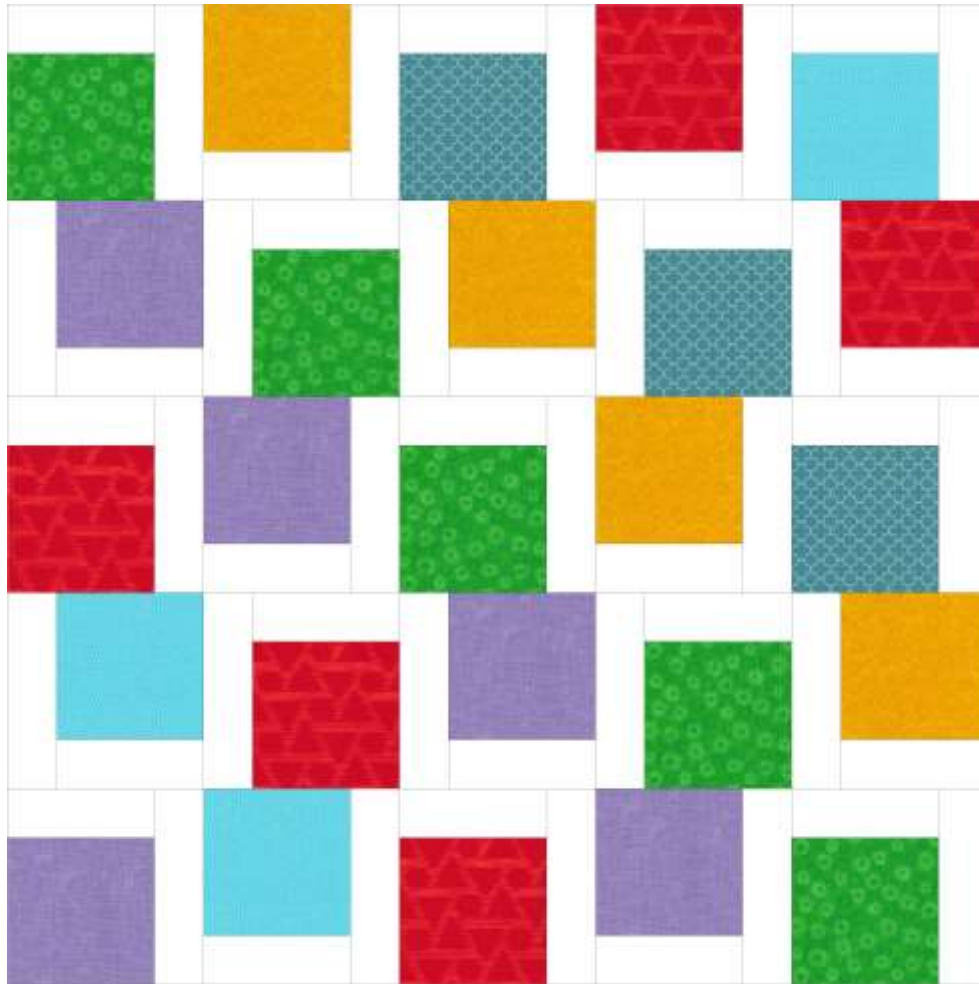
Twin Charms Tumbling

Twin Charms Tumbling is a quick easy quilt layout that is perfect for using pre-cuts such as charm squares.

Any size squares can be used
BUT 5" AND 6" SQUARES ARE IDEAL
for quick baby quilts!

The blocks are all constructed the same way.

The quilt layout is what gives the quilt the pizzazz!

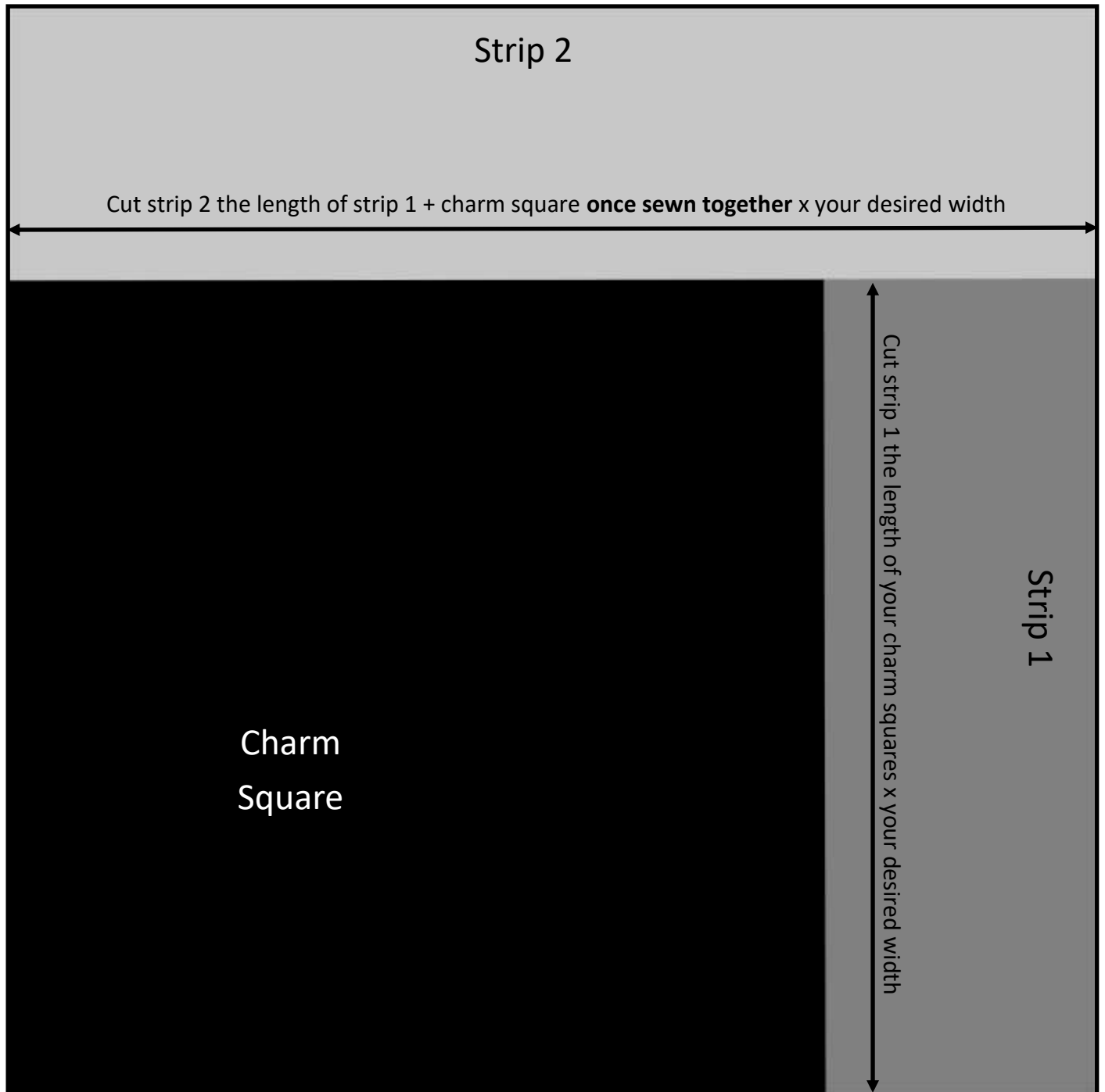
Strip width can be whatever you prefer.

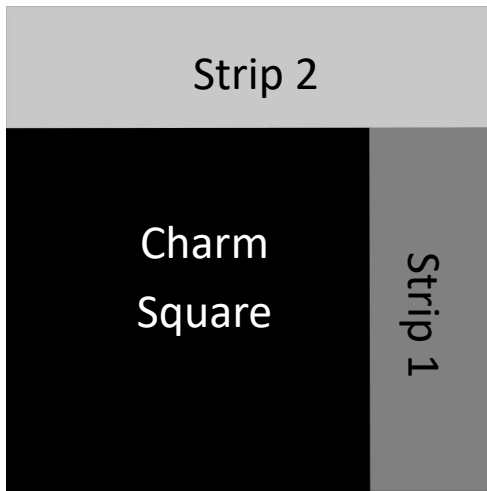
here are two examples:

5" CHARM SQUARES CUT 2" STRIPS OF FABRIC

6" CHARM SQUARES CUT 2.5" STRIPS OF FABRIC

The basic block has 3 pieces
1 charm square
& 2 strips

Imagine that each block has an arrow of directionality pointing towards the framed corner as shown below.

Now the layout involves simple block rotation.

Row 1

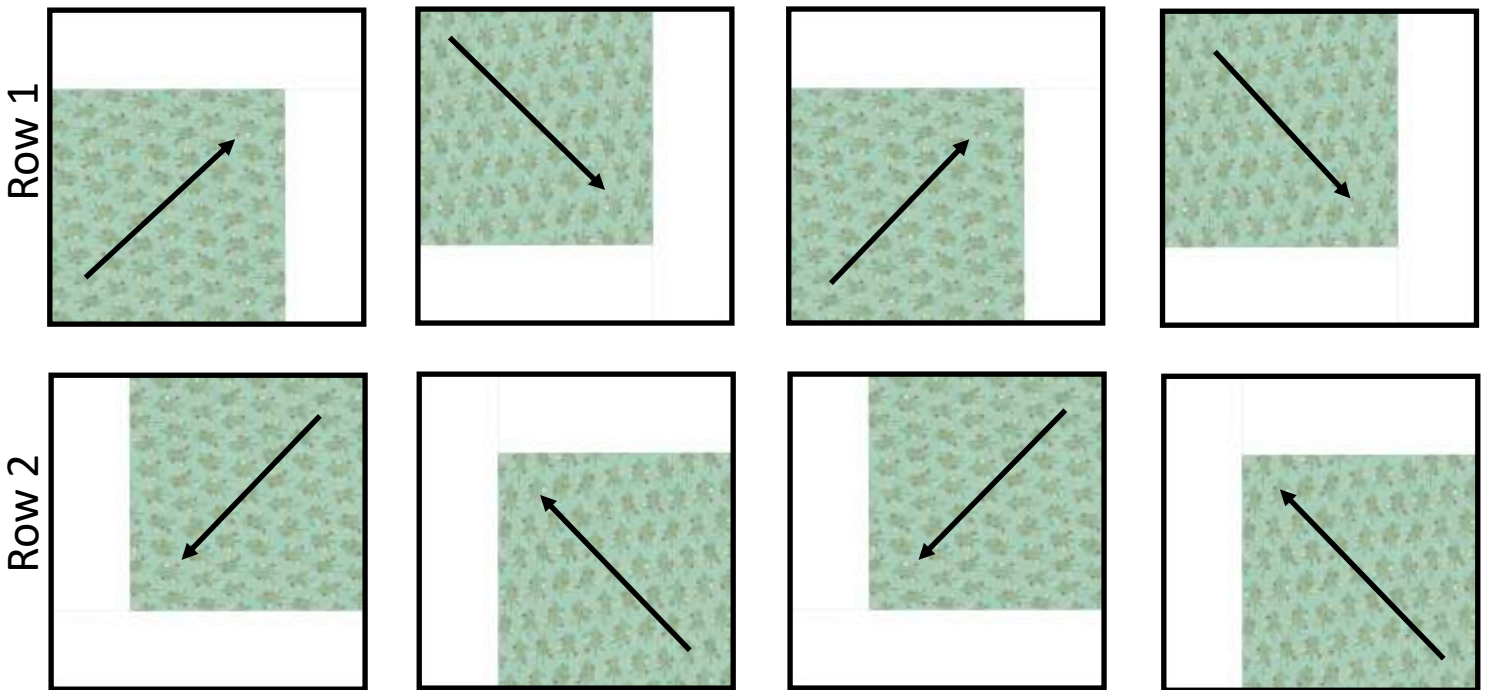
Place block 1

now place block two adjacent to it and rotate 90 degrees right

Block 3 is positioned the same as block 1 - continue across the row

Block 1

Block 2

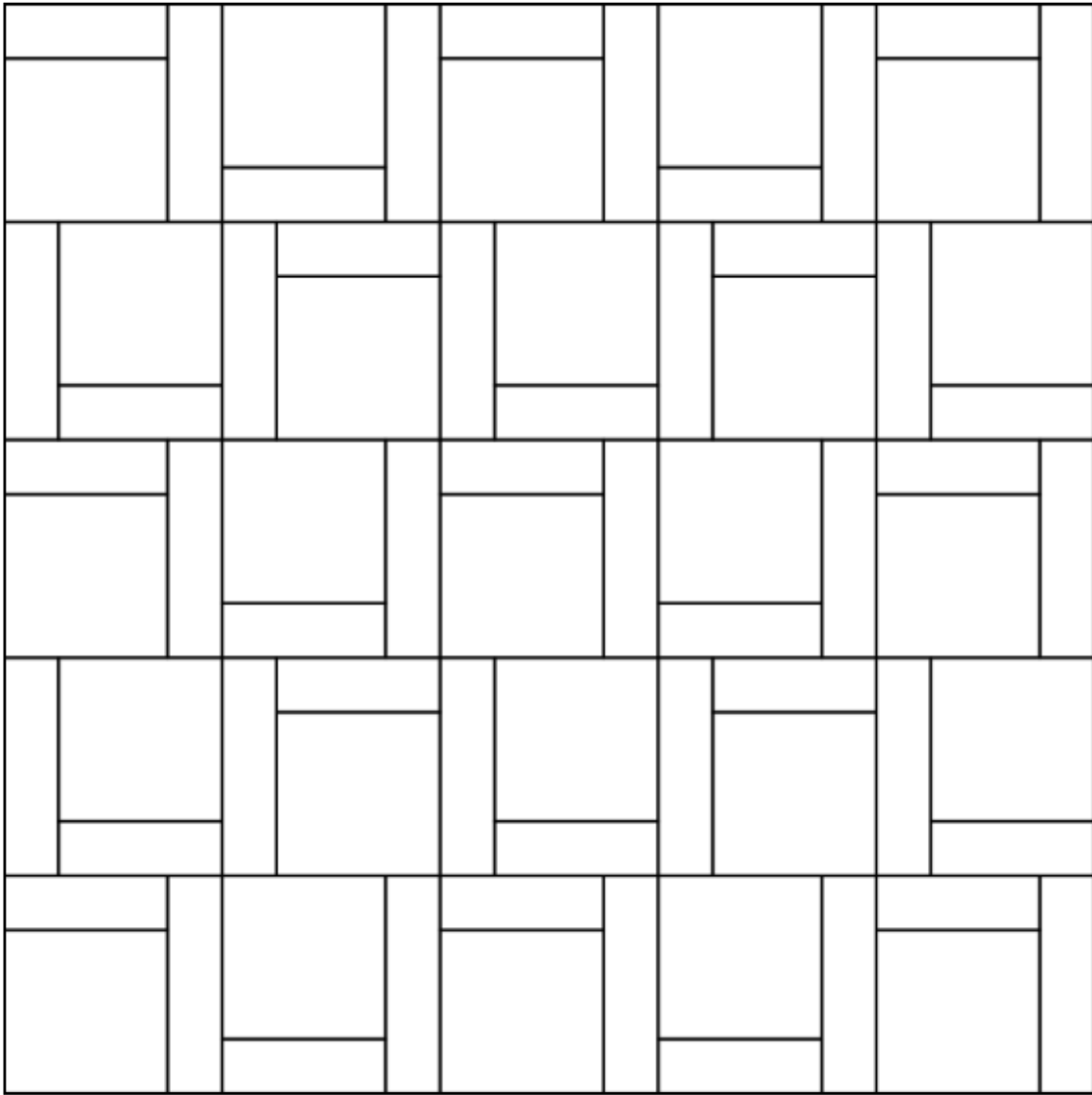


Row 2

Place block 1 as shown

now place block two adjacent to it and rotate 90 degrees right

block 3 is positioned the same as block 1 - continue across the row

TIP

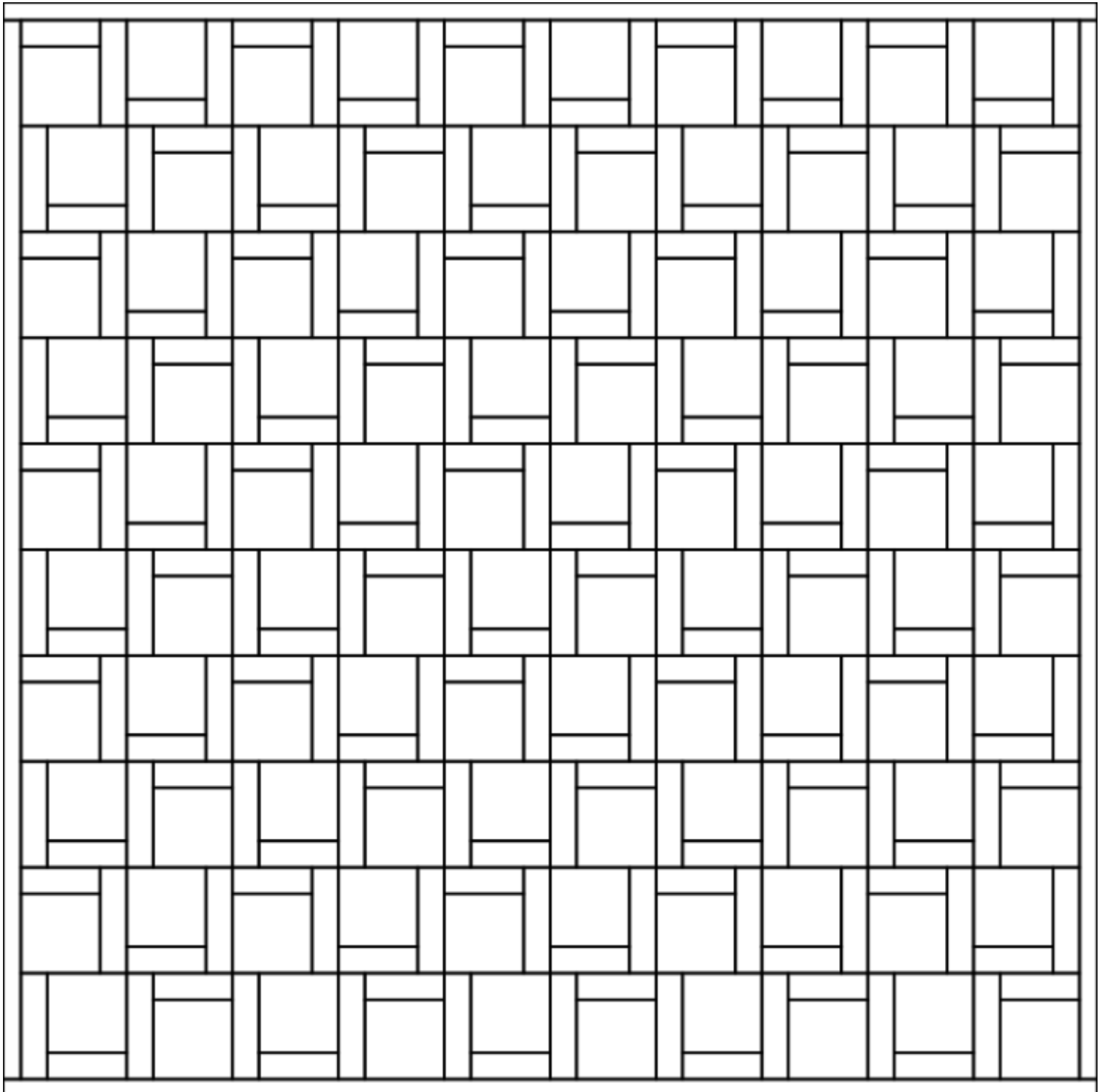
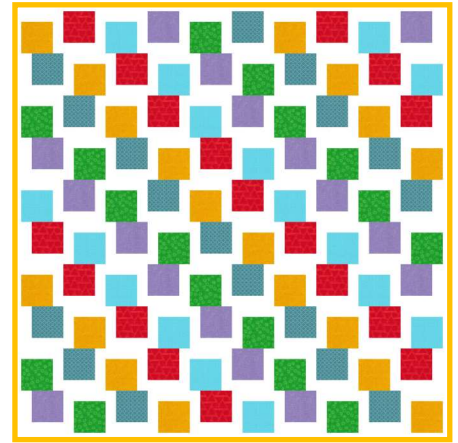
Double and triple check the block directions before sewing rows together. This pattern can be visually confusing to the eye!
